Who Are WLA?

Established in 2011, WLA's 28 founding members represented in 5 countries

Women Leaders in Action (WLA) is a women's resource group that unites senior members of U.S. Bank's payment services division. WLA's mission is to connect high-performing women through professional and personal resources and provide support to community-based programs. Through shared experience and networks, WLA manages and produces programs to inspire women to excel in their personal and professional lives.



WLA Kids

Women Leaders in Action partnered with Rotarians For Fighting AIDS (RFFA) and launched WLA Kids, which improves the lives of the orphans and vulnerable children of Africa through education.

There are 20 million orphans and vulnerable children on the continent of Africa who have lost one or both parents to the AIDs pandemic. These children have no hope for a better future without the basic necessities of healthcare, food, clean water and education. School is not free in Africa, and without education, the cycle of poverty continues.

Through fund raising projects, like this Fashion Event and a hands on approach, WLA has 'adopted' a Maasai village south of Nairobi, called Oldonyonyokie. Program support includes school fees for 100 children for four years, school uniforms and supplies, malaria treated bed nets, solar study lamps, furnishing a primary school girl's dorm and a solar-powered computer lab. This support will significantly impact these children's lives and give them the opportunity to lead healthy and hopeful lives.
